*NRTC is a “mask-friendly” campus for students. Students are allowed to wear appropriate masks according to personal and family preference throughout the school day. (Masks will be required at all contingency levels for Early Childhood Career students because they are working in proximity to pre-school children.)

**Note that in-person hands-on learning opportunities are planned at all levels of COVID response. During a potential building shutdown, NRTC Admin and Instructors will work closely with Nevada R-5 Administration and local health officials to allow limited building access for the purpose of hands-on skill development. Career and Technical Education programs of study demand the teaching and practice of industry aligned skills. Many of these skills cannot be mastered in a virtual learning environment.

***Sending school students who exhibit COVID19 symptoms during the school day will be temporarily isolated until contact is made with the sending school administration. Transportation arrangements will be made on a case-by-case basis if it is determined that the student should return home for self-monitoring or care.

****The district will be working closely with the Vernon County Health Department to manage any possible cases of COVID.
